

**Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture
The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)
EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014 - JUNE 30, 2015**

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) is a supplemental food program operated with surplus commodities provided by the U.S. Government. TEFAP is operated in accordance with USDA policy, which prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability. Lebanon County Christian Ministries is the designated agency to administer TEFAP for Lebanon County. Eligibility for this program is based upon the following income guidelines (150% of Poverty):
